

## GUIDELINES FOR CLEANING AN ISOLATION AREA

This area where possible should be cleaned last..

- Wash hands and dry thoroughly.
  - Collect all equipment required for cleaning the area and wear a plastic apron and disposable gloves.
  - Always dispose of cloths after use or use blue paper roll for cleaning.
  - Discard items of rubbish into a yellow bag (hazardous waste).
  - All surfaces should be cleaned first using a detergent solution, starting with the locker and finishing with the bin, i.e. cleanest items to dirtiest.
  - Hard flooring should then be mopped with a detergent solution, carpeted areas should be vacuumed and shampooed.
  - After the area is dry, a final bleach clean should be carried out wiping over hard surfaces and mopping hard flooring.
  - **BLEACH SOLUTION** Add 1 bleach tablet to  $\frac{1}{2}$  a bucket of water and allow to dissolve before use.
  - Leave area taking sealed rubbish bag and equipment away, launder mop heads immediately.
  - Wash hands after removal of gloves and dry thoroughly.
